

Agreement for postponement of Final Screening and Certification
Training Program of Leaders for Integrated Medical System
for Fruitful Healthy-Longevity Society

(Purpose)

1. This is an agreement to set the requirements to postpone the Final Screening and Certification for the students of Training Program of Leaders for Integrated Medical System for Fruitful Healthy-Longevity Society (hereinafter called “LIMS program”)

(Requirements)

2. Students who wish to apply for postponement of the LIMS Final Screening and Certification should fulfill the following requirements:
Students should satisfy the number of years required for graduation under the guidance of their professor at their Graduate School listed in Table 1. Students who have already completed, or are expected to, complete all required credits, may apply.

(Term)

3. A maximum of three years postponement after the standard course duration listed in Table 1 will be allowed.

(Application)

4. Students who fulfill or are expected to fulfill the requirements stated in Article 2 should submit the following documents before the specified deadline to the program coordinator.
 - (1) Application for postponement of the LIMS Final Screening and Certification (Form1)
 - (2) Instructions document from the Academic Supervisor (Form 2)

(Assessment and Report)

5. The program coordinator will examine the application based on Article 2 at the meeting of the LIMS Final Screening Committee. In addition, the results of English debating skills based on an oral examination will be reported at the LIMS program professors meeting.

(Confirmation)

6. At the LIMS program professors meeting, application for postponement of LIMS Final Screening and Certification will be confirmed based on the assessment described above.
 - 2 The program coordinator will submit the document for postponement of the LIMS Final Screening and Certification (Form 3) to the Leading Graduate School Programs Steering Committee.
